Advance notice of fundraising: fight food poverty

This year, we are fighting food poverty with food. For twelve consecutive Sundays, from February 25th to May 19th inclusive¹, I am hosting a lunch for paid guests in my own home.

The meal is a traditional Sunday roast followed by dessert or cheese and biscuits. Tea, coffee and soft drinks included. A donation of £25 per diner is requested.² Gross proceeds to Christian Aid. You are welcome to bring your own bottle, if required.

Places are limited to six guests per meal. Advance booking essential. I intend to start almost immediately in the hope of reaching a target of £1500.

It will give those of us who live alone the chance to dine in the company of friends and meet new ones (no washing up!) as well as benefitting those less fortunate than ourselves.

The venue is 1 Hunter Drive, Thurston, IP31 3QQ, off Barton Road (next to the Fox and Hounds). Parking permitted on Barton Road.
